Travelling to Helsinki

Helsinki is located on the south coast of Finland and can be best reached by plane or boat. There are direct flights from most European capitals, operated by various airlines, including

Travelling to Park Hotel Käpylä

All attendees will be accommodated at Park Hotel Käpylä. The hotel is located in the middle of an idyllic wooden town part, 6 kilometers from the city centre and 4 kilometers from the Viikki campus, surrounded by rustic wooden homes and gardens. Park Hotel Käpylä has an indoor pool and a fitness facility that can be used free of charge and a possibility to visit a sauna for an additional fee. The property offers also a wireless Internet access.

Reaching the hotel from the Helsinki-Vantaa airport:

Taxis are quite expensive, but participants arriving around the same time can share a reasonably priced group taxi (10-20€ per passenger). A more affordable option is to take a bus (61) to the Tikkurila Railway Station (~20min) and by train (I or N) to Käpylä Railway Station (~10min). The hotel is a 5min walk away from the Käpylä station (refer to the attached photo).

Reaching the hotel from ferry terminals:

- Olympia Terminal to the *Central Railway Station*: tram 3T (10min)
- Katajanokan Terminal to the *Central Railway Station*: tram 4/4T (10min)
- Länsisatama Terminal to the *Central Railway Station*: bus 15 (20min)
- Hansa Terminal to the *Central Railway Station*: bus 90A
- Hansa Terminal to the Vuosaari metro station: bus 90B and then metro (there is only one metro line) to the *Central Railway Station* (30min)

From the *Central Railway Station*, you take train I or N, and get off at Käpylä train station (refer to the attached photo).
